Purpose: In accordance with the Rockbridge County Code Chapter 23, this policy will provide proper disposal method for Burned Residential Structure(s) in the County of Rockbridge.

Scope: This policy shall apply to all residential property owners in the County of Rockbridge.

Policy: In the event that a fire destroys a Rockbridge County property owner's primary residence, and the remnants of the structure are delivered to the Blue Ridge Resource Authority (BRR) regional landfill, Rockbridge County may provide assistance in covering directly-associated tipping fee costs if such costs are not covered by homeowner's or other insurance.

Any resident applying for such relief must provide evidence that insurance does not cover disposal costs. If given proof that insurance will not cover tipping fees, the County will consider financial assistance to abate such costs, through a hardship grant. Such determinations will be made on a case-by case basis by the Board of Supervisors standing Solid Waste Committee.

This policy specifically excludes accessory structures and commercial properties, including rental housing.

This policy shall be effective on and from the date of its adoption.
